Information for participants

Dear Friend,

Here is information for those interested in joining the Tefillah Trip to Radin or Vilna on Shabbos Kodesh, פרשת יתרו תשפ"ב.

1. Dirshu's Shabbos Convention will take place, י"ח, on Shabbos Kodesh, כ' שבט, פרשת יתרו.
2. On Thursday night, י"ט שבט, a tefillah will be held in Radin (Belarus) at the same time as one at the tziyun of the גר"א in Vilna (Lithuania).
3. In light of the difficulty faced in crossing the border between Belarus and Lithuania, a limited delegation of רבנים will go to Radin and continue on to Vilna – to be at Dirshu's Shabbos Convention in Vilna.
4. We offer two options for participating in the trip, without crossing the Belarus-Lithuania border:

Option A

Radin – Chaika – Belarus

Travelling directly to Belarus, and participation in the tefillah at the קבר of the Chofetz Chaim, זצ"א
After the seudas mitzvah in Yeshivas Radin – option for stops in Volozhin – Minsk – Mir.
Spending Shabbos at the Chaika Recreation Complex, hosted and under the responsibility of Harav Hagoon Moshe Fhima, Head of the Karlin stolin institutions in Belarus.

Departure from Israel to Belarus – Thursday, 1:30 p.m. (departure from Israel)

Returning to Israel from Belarus – Sunday 1:20 p.m. (arrival in Israel)

Cost: NIS 1,500 (excluding airplane ticket)

Option B

Vilna – Kovno – Lithuania

Travelling directly to Lithuania, and participation in the tefillah at the קבר of the גר"א, זצ"א
Participation in the Dirshu Shabbos Convention at the Kempinski Hotel, Vilnius (Vilna), and a tour of the city of Vilna, Kovno, and קברימים of Gedolei Yisroel

Departure from Israel to Lithuania – Thursday – detailed information will be provided later

Returning to Israel from Lithuania – Sunday 6:10 p.m. (arrival in Israel)

Cost **per person in single room: NIS 2,900** (excluding airplane ticket)

Cost **per person in double room: NIS 2,200** (excluding airplane ticket)

Important:

- Travel to Belarus is only possible for those who have been given 2 or 3 doses of vaccine and no more than 180 days have elapsed since the last vaccine. Those who are not vaccinated will be required to perform a test for coronavirus 48 hours before departure. Likewise medical insurance is required for the entire stay.
- Entrance to Belarus without a visa is only possible for those holding an Israeli passport
- Travel to Vilna is only possible for those who have been given 2 or 3 doses of vaccine and no more than 180 days have elapsed since the last vaccine. Likewise medical insurance is required for the entire stay.
- We are not offering the option of a trip which includes crossing the Belarus-Vilna border
- The trip is for men only
